We will be having an Open House on Thursday, September 3, 2009, from 6:30-8:30pm. All classrooms will be open, and staff members will be here to meet parents. Open House Night provides a grand opportunity for you to learn what to expect this academic year at Lifeline.

Student Attendance

Attendance at school is important for school, as well as student success. However, if your child needs to be absent from school, please notify the Attendance Office between 7:00- 7:30 a.m. on the day of the absence. For absences longer than three days, please be aware that your child must return to school with a doctor's excuse. We will be closely monitoring the attendance of all students and we will be inquiring if your child is not present in school. Please do not be offended if we call, we just care that your child is not in attendance at school. Our school goal for attendance is 97%, which means that a student cannot miss more than 5 days in an entire school year.
